Van Zelst, Inc., a design-build landscape contractor, won gold and silver awards at the Illinois Landscape Contractors Assn. (ILCA) meeting held in Chicago.

The Wadsworth-based firm is active in design, construction and maintenance of landscapes for homes, businesses and institutions in northeast Illinois.

"There is a growing trend in the industry for one firm to handle the total landscape project from design through the final construction phase and then maintain the property. The ILCA awards reflect this design-build concept," David Van Zelst, landscape architect and firm president said.

"The association looks for quality and workmanship in landscaping," Greg Rippel, landscape architect said.

A gold award for excellence in landscape design and construction was given for a Libertwille residence. The home was constructed two years before the landscape project began. A major objective was to solve horticultural problems caused by the original construction process in which tree root zones had been compacted, resulting in loss of trees. New drainage systems were developed and special mixes of soils used to protect remaining and newly planted trees.

Extensive lighting was used as a final touch.

A gold award was received for a two-acre residential property in a wooded area of Lake Forest. Perennial gardens, groundcover beds, bluestone hardscapes and sparkling turf are features.

The company's silver award


came for a landscape design and construction of a residential project in Barrington. The landscape elements complimented the prairie surrounding the home. Features include a 150 foot prairie garden that runs along the property's edge.
